

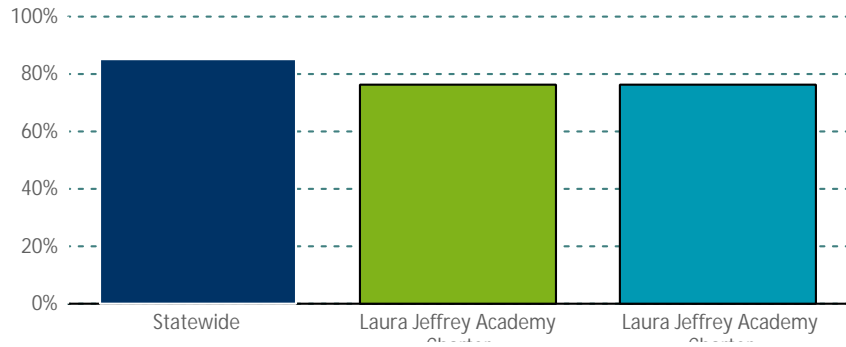

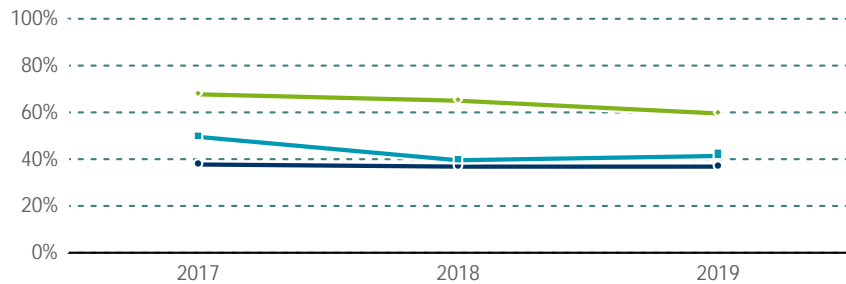

Admission is open to all students, regardless of gender, race, religion, sexual orientation, ability, or economic status. LJA is particularly focused on developing students' critical thinking skills. Students use habits of reasoning, reading, writing and speaking to understand the root causes and consequences of public and personal actions. By taking a critical look at knowledge, students learn to access the power of information for personal and public benefit. Ultimately this access, in combination with critical thinking skills, leads to freedom in making decisions and power to realize their talents and potential. The LJA curriculum focuses on increasing competence and confidence in math and science through a comprehensive liberal arts education. Arts, music and technology are essential parts of the curriculum. Learning is a social experience where students develop the skills to set goals and solve problems. Small classes and low student-to-educator ratio ensure that students get individualized attention.
